

# 週年感言

羅馬不是一日造成的，台灣網路資訊中心（TWNIC）在正式成立為法人之前，也是經過數年來的努力，歷經三個階段，才有今日的成果。從第一階段1994年3月開始進行為期二年的「台灣網路資訊中心（TWNIC）實驗計畫」，至1996年6月成立「中華民國電腦學會台灣網路資訊中心」第二階段開始正式上路運轉，雖然高興TWNIC的逐漸成長，但鑑於長期運作之考量，也不免開始憂心以義工性質的組織實無法處理與服務規模日益茁壯之網路社會，須以健全組織與專人專職服務機制來運作，所以到1998年4月行政院NII推動小組「召開研商台灣網路資訊中心未來運作方向」會議，會中決議由交通部電信總局為台灣網路資訊中心之主管機關，負責監督輔導該中心轉型成為公益性之財團法人，隨後即進行第三階段並提出轉型計劃書報院核定、捐助章程之擬定與討論、董監事名單之確定，並於1999年12月29日正式完成法人登記程序。這一路走來，感謝教育部一開始的大力推動，中華民國電腦學會、國家高速電腦中心、中華電信數據通信分公司、資策會、交通大學、中央大學、中山大學、HiNet、SEEDNet等以及其他相關單位與各理監事委員的積極參與和無私的奉獻，同時更感謝行政院NII小組與交通部電信總局的支持和協助，以及各界人士所給意見與鼓勵，幫助財團法人TWNIC奠定了日後運作的良好基礎。

回顧過去的一年，感謝各董監事及委員的辛勞，提供各項專業建言和積極參與協助多項網路界重大的決議與活動。如國際事務委員會，為了即時掌握國際網路發展的重要資訊，多次代表出席CANN、APNIC等組織所舉辦的國際會議，也陸續邀請相關人員來台發表網際網路趨勢及資訊技術交流，爭取到APTLD來台設置秘書處等相關事項及Internet相關權益，並與國際間建立良好的溝通管道與友誼；網域名稱委員會針對中文網域註冊、網域名稱爭議處理辦法機制及開放代辦網域名稱註冊服務等相關議題，更是召開多次會議並及時提出解決方案，支應變化急遽的網際網路環境；IP位址及協定委員會更是針對IPv4/IPv6舉辦多次的研討會及訓練課程，提昇IP申請時效及完整性，加強有效的使用與管理。近日來，為了加強防範網路犯罪，TWNIC也已於2000年10月30日第五次董監事會通過增設網路安全委員會，結合台灣電腦網路危機處理中心推動全國網路安全檢測機制。

在此，我也要特別感謝陳執行長在這一年多來的辛勞，帶領中心同仁一步步朝著目標邁進，使中心成長的腳步走的更穩健、踏實。

為我國網際網路事業提供最佳服務，是TWNIC成立為財團法人之最大目的。希望我們團隊能儘最大努力，以前瞻的眼光、宏觀的角度研擬適合由TWNIC推動之任務，提昇專業能力以掌握尖端技術，提供優質的服務，推廣我國Internet多元化網路普及應用。

# Anniversary Remarks

Rome was not built in a day. Before becoming officially incorporated, the Taiwan Network Information Center (TWNIC), too, had to toil for many years and through three stages to get where it is today. March 1994 saw the beginning of the first stage-the two-year TWNIC Experiment Project. This ended in June of 1996 with the second stage-the founding of the TWNIC under the China Computer Society(CCS). Despite our pleasure with the TWNIC's steady growth, based on long-term hopes for TWNIC, we could not help but concern ourselves that a voluntary organization under CCS would not be able to handle and serve the increasingly large Internet community. We would need a sound and professional service organization. In April 1998, therefore, the Executive Yuan's NII Promotion Team convened a conference to discuss the future direction of TWNIC operations during which it was resolved that the Directorate General of Telecommunications under the Ministry of Transportation & Communications would oversee TWNIC as it was transformed into a public corporation. In the ensuing third stage, the TWNIC sent its plan for incorporation to the Executive Yuan for approval, to draw up by laws, and to confirm the list of names for the boards of directors and supervisors. Official incorporation registration procedures were completed on 29 December 1999. I would like to express my gratitude for the endeavor given by the Ministry of Education at the beginning as well as the active participation and selfless hard work of the China Computer Society, the National High Speed Computer Center, Data Communication Business Group of Chunghwa Telecom Co., Ltd., Institute for Information Industry, National Chiao Tung University, National Central University, National Sun Yat-sen University, HiNet, SEEDNet, and all the other organizations as well as the members of the boards of directors and supervisors, the support and assistance of the Executive Yuan's NII Steering Committee and the Directorate General of Telecommunications under the Ministry of Transportation & Communications, and everybody's recommendations and encouragement in helping TWNIC lay down a firm foundation for future operations.

Looking back over the past year, I feel obligated to extend my heartfelt appreciation to all members of the boards of directors and supervisors as well as committee members for their hard work in offering expert advice and for their participation and hard work in many important Internet related resolutions and activities. The International Affairs Committee, for example, has represented us several times in attending international conferences, including ICANN and APNIC, and has invited specialists to Taiwan to speak on Internet trends and to partake in information technology exchanges to keep us abreast of important Internet developments. They also managed to persuade APTLD to set up its secretariat in Taiwan, have fought for Taiwan's Internet interests, and set up communication channels and friendships between Taiwan and other countries. The Domain Name Committee has convened numerous meetings and proposed solutions to tackle topics ranging from Chinese domain name registration and a domain name dispute resolution mechanism to opening up domain name registration to registrars to deal with the rapidly changing Internet landscape. The IP Address and Protocol Committees has held a number of seminars and training sessions on Ipv4/Ipv6 to enhance IP application and improve the effective use and management thereof. During the fifth meeting of the boards of directors and supervisors held on 30 October 2000, TWNIC passed a move to set up an Network Security Committee to further strengthen anti-crime measures on the Internet to work with the Taiwan Computer Emergency Response Center to create a national Internet security testing mechanism.

I would also like to take this opportunity to express my appreciation to Executive Director Chen for his leadership and steady hand over the past year in guiding the TWNIC staff ever more closely to their objectives.

The incorporation of TWNIC was aimed at providing Taiwan's Internet industry with the best service possible. It is my hope that we use a macro-vision and focus our energies on searching for missions that best suit TWNIC to enhance our professionalism and keep abreast of the latest technologies to provide top quality services and promote a diversified Internet in Taiwan.
